A floor lamp Which materials are: Lycra, Wire, a brass base and electric components. It is made up of two wire structures, which are flexible enough to be given several Kinds of shapes. Because of it is struture, it can be easily transformed into another decorative luminaire- it is like to have several luminaires in one. So, it can easily be turned into a flower, a sphare or cilinder, according to the required decorative effect, or just for fun. The lighting impact comes mainly from the top of the struture.
