

GreenLight – Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
In what format should the application be fulfilled?	Instructions on how to fill in the GL programme application are available on the www.eu-greenlight.org website or with the National Contact Points (see the list of contacts) who can provide you with exact documents and instructions.
Are there options for financing lighting projects from public sources?	Guidance on the available national and European subsidy schemes usable for the energy efficient lighting projects is available from the National Contact Points, Within the GreenLight programme, no subsidy schemes are offered.
What are the best methods of the marketing promotion of being a partner of the GreenLight programme?	Active promotion of the partners' membership in GreenLight is possible by press releases, articles, web updates, plaques etc. The National Contact Points can offer help in organizing further national and local promotion activities.
What kind of projects are eligible for being part of the GreenLight programme	All kind of completed (less than 3 years) and planned energy efficient lighting reconstructions in buildings or outdoor lighting sectors. Consult the "Guidelines for Partners" document for more details.
What are the potential benefits from taking part on the programme?	First of all, it is the energy savings achieved by the lighting system upgrade. Secondly, it is the public recognition of the company/municipality and its activities.
What is it defined the quality level of the product(s) offered by GL endorser to potential partner in the framework of the GreenLight programme?	The GreenLight programme is not a quality guarantee programme of lighting products. Endorsers are welcomed to promote the GreenLight programme to its clients, but individual products are not listed as "GreenLight certified".
What are the best technical solutions for energy efficient lighting systems in office buildings?	Individual technical consultation is provided by National Contact Points and endorsers (if applicable).
In what way do the GreenLight partners commit to the programme?	The partnership is based on a self commitment to reduce energy consumption which should be a target for every individual company – GreenLight should be recognised as a support tool to achieve this goal/target.
